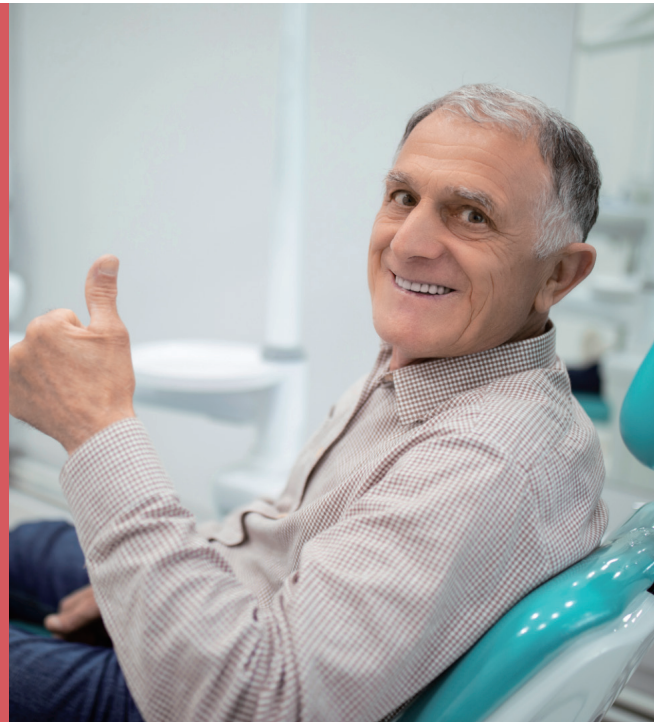

VICTORIA'S PUBLIC DENTAL CARE SERVICES

Victorian pensioners are eligible for public dental care services, and some people receive priority access to those services. If you have denture care needs, you will be offered the next available appointment for denture care or placed on the priority denture waiting list. Public dental services are provided through the Royal Dental Hospital Melbourne and over 50 integrated and registered community health services in suburbs such as Footscray, Niddrie, Kensington, St Albans etc.
