By entering the competition, you agree to the following Terms & Conditions:

- a. The AMCS Art Against Ageism Competition is open to all ages.
- b. A parent or guardian must apply on behalf of the applicant if the applicant is under 18 years old
- c. Applicants may enter an unlimited number of submissions
- d. There is no entry fee for submission.
- e. Deadline for entries is Sunday 10th September 2023, 11:59pm (Melbourne Time)
- f. AMCS will award one first-place winner and one second-place prize winner
- g. The number of finalists is at the sole discretion of the judging panel
- h. Copyright of the artwork remains the property of the artist
- i. AMCS will use personal information collected in the submission process to contact applicants and will be handled according to the Privacy Act.
- j. The applicant acknowledges and agrees that as part of the application process, they will provide personal information such as name, email address, phone number, and country of residence.
- k. The applicant acknowledges and agrees that AMCS may use the artwork for marketing purposes.
- l. Australian Multicultural Community Services reserves the right to substitute judges.
- m. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into
- n. Successful applicants will be advised by phone and/or email that they have been selected as Finalists. If AMCS has not received a response to any email or phone message within 10 days of the first notification (Australia time), an alternative Finalist may be selected.
- o. Applicants agree to indemnify Australian Multicultural Community Services Ltd. For any possible loss or legal action against it in relation to artwork submitted by them.
- p. By entering the AMCS Art Against Ageism competition, the applicant confirms that they are the creator and owner of the work, that the applicant has the permission of the subject, or, where appropriate, the subject's parent/guardian, that the work does not infringe copyright or indigenous culture and intellectual property, the submission was not taken in circumstances of trespass or invading anyone's legal right of privacy, confidentiality, breach of industrial law or applicable industry code and does not to the best of their knowledge defame anyone nor was their conduct in creating the submission likely to be misleading or deceptive and that they agree with these Terms & Conditions
- q. All terms and conditions may be updated at Australian Multicultural Community Services' discretion
- r. Australian Multicultural Community Services is entitled to exclude or remove from the AMCS Art Against Ageism Competition 2023 any submissions by an applicant who has submitted false information or who does not comply with all Terms and Conditions set out by Australian Multicultural Community Services.
